Catholic Charities has been called to welcome and care for the migrant youth arriving in San Antonio, and we invite you to join us. Please help us welcome our neighbor and show Christ's love to some of the most vulnerable in our community.

We are looking for 40 volunteers each day, age 18 or older to assist at the Freeman Coliseum with the migrant children placed there for short-term shelter. There are three volunteer shifts: 7:00 am – 4:30 pm, 4:00 pm – 11:30 pm, and 11:00 pm – 8:00 am. Bilingual speakers are preferred.

For the safety of those being served, there are a few easy steps to become a volunteer:

1. Register online as a volunteer (<https://www.givepulse.com/group/9056-Catholic-Charities-of-San-Antonio>).
2. Potential Volunteers will be asked to consent to a criminal background check.
3. Once approved, volunteers will be contacted to choose a volunteer shift.
