For fifty # years as a Daughter of Charity, Bakhita provided cheerful hospitality to all who knocked at the con- 🤻 vent door. In her final illness, she # relived slavery's horror: "Please, loosen these chains," she begged the nurse. "They are so heavy!" Her last words were: "Our Lady! * Our Lady!" John Paul II canonized * her in the Jubilee Year 2000, praising God for leading her "from ab- * iect slavery to the dignity of being your daughter and the Bride of \$\frac{\pi}{*}\$ Christ."


