THANK YOU FROM SVDP

We want to thank you very much for your continued and generous support to SVDP at St. Stanislaus.

For our fiscal year ending September 30th, your contributions totaled \$63,668.00. This allowed us to help 872 people in need, 261 with utility assistance and 708 with food assistance.

The need in our area continues to be high. We have first time individuals almost every week. We have people call because they have no place to live and have been living in their vehicle. While we don't have a facility or place for them to live, we help them with their rent and utilities when they find housing.

We got a call from a person living in a tent. She had no water as it had been turned off and asked for our help to get it turned back on. We were able to do so.

We had a mother visit us who was fully employed. She recently had a family member in hospice. She was also supporting her adult children and grandchildren. The reason for her visit was pending disconnection of her electric. We visited her at her home, paid her electric bill and also provided her with budgeting instructions. After about three months, the two members who met with her received a text thanking them for all the help they had provided. She had been closely watching her budget and she had been able to turn herself around financially.

Recently a couple called us because they were going to be evicted. They have a large family with three generations living in one house. She was hospitalized with major medical issues and was let go by her employer as a result. The rent due was \$1,500. Two of our members visited them and suggested they talk to the landlord who was charging daily late fees. In conversation with the landlord they were able to get all the late fees cancelled and provide us with another day to pay. Locally we paid \$600, and with help from Fredericksburg, Honey Creek and St Elizabeth Ann Seton we were able to pay the bill. The mother got a new job and both her husband and mother are now working, so we are hopeful they will be able to keep up in the future. Without your generous support we would be unable to report these happy endings. Thank you so very much, Bob Bashaw, President.
